1. As per the directions of the Election commission of India and the office of the chief electoral officer in Bihar, raids against illicit liquor are being carried out for the effective management and coordination of free and fair election in the forthcoming election in Bihar. Under this campaign today, 2714 litres of illicit liquor, 18 cartridges were seized. Further, in Sheikhpura District Rs. 8,50,000/- and Banka District Rs. 66,000/- cash is also seized.

4. Today, a State Level Training-cum-Workshop was also organised for the Returning Officers and Asstt. Returning Officers from the District Rohtas, Munger, Lakhisarai, Nawada, Jamui, Kaimur and Banka in the Conference Hall of the office of the Chief Electoral Officer, Bihar. In the workshop, the participants of the above mentioned seven Districts were briefed in details about the guidelines and the directions of the Election Commission of India on

matters such as, process of nomination, scrutiny, eligibility of nomination, point of disqualification, withdrawal of name, preparation of final list of the contesting candidate and the allocation of the symbols to the candidates.

Video films produced by the Election Commission of India on the above subjects were also shown. Finally, the participants queries pertaining to these matters were also addressed in this workshop.

5. A meeting was held today, with District Election Officer, Patna and SSP, Patna with the officers of Airport Authority and CISF. All the Passengers/baggages/materials coming to the Jai Prakash Narayan International Airport will be monitored /inspected /screened through standard procedure. Only authorized personnel's or baggages shall be allowed enter through the main gate of the airport. During electoral process, the movement of all private aeroplanes/helicopters will be restricted only to Jai Prakash Narayan International Airport. Materials shall not be stored in aircrafts halting for long duration at the airport which will also be monitored by the CISF officers.
