

Press Release

1. As per the directions of the Election commission of India and the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer in Bihar, raids against illicit liquor are being carried out for the effective management of the free and fair election in Bihar. Under this campaign today, total 7382 litres of illicit liquor were seized.

Cash amounting to Rs. 92,010/- from District Supual, Rs. 55,000/- from District Araria, Rs. 70,000/- from District Darbhanga, Rs. 1,36,600/- from District Samastipur, Rs. 5,25,000/- from District Begusarai and Rs. 87,990/- from District Buxar has been recovered during checking, which is under investigation by Police and Income Tax authority.

4. District Election Officers of all Districts were reviewed by the Chief Secretary through the Video Conference regarding the preparation of Bihar Assembly General Election, 2015. In today's conference, the Chief Secretary of Bihar reviewed matters related to preventive action taken against anti social element, action against illegal liquor, seizure of illegal arms, District wise status of need of vehicles/ its availability and directions were also issued to those Districts who have not been able to take expected action and instructed to review on this point regular basis and improve it.

The Chief Secretary reviewed different Department/ District regarding the action taken under the provision of basis minimum facility at all Polling Stations. The instructions were also issued to all District Election Officers to ensure basic minimum facilities such as ramp (based on the standard slop), drinking water, separate toilet for male and female, electricity (with alternative arrangement), etc. in all Districts of the State.

Chief Electoral Officer of Bihar reviewed all District Election Officers in details regarding the preparedness of Bihar Assembly General Election, 2015. In this meeting matters related to modal code of conduct, law and order, election expenditure monitoring, voter awareness under SVEEP and other programmes were discussed.

5. A meeting was held with the representative of all the affiliated political parties regarding the management of electoral process in the context of Bihar Assembly General Election, 2015. In the meeting held at the Conference hall today, the representatives of the political parties were requested to share their suggestion/remarks during the proposed meeting with the Election Commission of India on 27th and 28th September, 2015.
