1. As per the directions of the Election commission of India and the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer in Bihar, raids against illicit liquor are being carried out for the effective management of the free and fair election in Bihar. Under this campaign today, total 16,362 litres of illicit liquor were seized. In addition to that 207 Kg “Mahua” from District Khagaria, 450 Kg alongwith 6 blank cartridges were seized.

Cash amounting to Rs. 4,05,000/- from District Aurangbad, Rs. 2,87,200/- from District Sheikhpura and Rs. 1,00,000/- from District Nawada has been recovered during checking, which is under investigation by Police and Income Tax authority.
