1. As per the directions of the Election commission of India and the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer in Bihar, raids against illicit liquor are being carried out for the effective management of the free and fair election in Bihar. Under this campaign today, total 7,725 litres of illicit liquor were seized.

Cash amounting to Rs. 2,66,070/- from District Rohtas has been recovered during checking, which is under investigation by Police and Income Tax authority.
