

Press Release

Date 6.10.2015

1. As per the directions of the Election commission of India and the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer in Bihar, raids against illicit liquor are being carried out for the effective management of the free and fair election in Bihar. Under this campaign, 2,699 litres was seized till date.

Cash amounting to Rs. 1,00,000/- from District West Champaran, Rs. 2,51,900/- from District Sheohar, Rs. 1,00,000/- from District Madhubani, Rs. 2,70,800/- from District Gopalganj, Rs. 5,01,965/- from District Siwan and Rs. 54,000/- from District Vaishali has been recovered during inspections, which is under investigation by Police and Income Tax authority.

During an election speech, in Sonatha High School on 04.10.2015 at Assembly Constituency (55-Kochadhaman), District Kishanganj, Sri Akbaruddin Owaisi, MIM leader referred Sri Narendra Modi as “Shaitan, Darinda” etc. This act has been observed under the violation of provisions under model code of conduct and an FIR (No. 159/15) has been registered under related section of IPC and Representation of Peoples Act on 04.10.2015.
6. During an election speech in Sindhaul under O.P. Muffassil Police Station of District Begusarai on 30.09.2015, Sri Amit Shah, President, Bharatiya Janata Party referred Sri Lalu Prasad Yadav as “Chara Chor”. This act has been registered under the violation of provisions under model code of conduct and an FIR (No. 389/15) has been registered under related section of IPC and Representation of Peoples Act on 05.10.2015.
7. During an election speech under Sikandra Police Station in District Jamui on 04.10.2015, Sri Lalu Prasad Yadav, President, Rashtriya Janata Dal referred Sri Amit Shah as “Narbhakshi”. This act has been registered under the violation of provisions under model code of conduct and an FIR (No. 129/15) has been registered under related section of IPC and Representation of Peoples Act on 06.10.2015.
8. While leaving his residence, a remark was made on 01.10.2015 by Sri Lalu Prasad Yadav, President, Rashtriya Janata Dal against Sri Amit Shah as “Narbhakshi”. This act has been registered under the violation of provisions under model code of conduct and an FIR (No. 122/15) has been registered at Schiwalaya Police Station under related section of IPC and Representation of Peoples Act on 06.10.2015.

9. Notification will be issued tomorrow for fourth phase of Bihar Assembly General Election, 2015 for 55 Assembly Constituencies. The Districts are West Champaran, East Champaran, Sheohar, Sitamarhi, Muzaffarpur, Gopalganj and Siwan on 07.10.2015, 14th October, 2015 is last date of nomination, 15th October, 2015 is the scrutiny, 17th October, 2015 for withdrawal of candidature and 1st November, 2015 is the Polling Date.
10. As per the direction of the Election Commission of India, candidates shall maintain their expenses register to be examined by Expenditure Observer. After the examination, the copy of the expenses register has to be up-loaded on DEOs website. The expense registers of the candidates are being examined of Districts going for 1st and 2nd phase elections. Arrangement has been made to upload the expenses register of the candidates on the website. District information officers have been made responsible for the implementation of the same.
11. Following nominations have been filed for the Assembly Election today 6.10.2015, for the third phase of the Bihar General Assembly Election – 2015
