1. As per the directions of the Election Commission of India and the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer in Bihar, raids against illicit liquor are being carried out for the effective management of the free and fair election in Bihar. Under this campaign today, total 30,365 litres of illicit liquor were seized.

Cash amounting to Rs. 3,96,000/- from District Araria, Rs. 1,16,250/- from District Saran, Rs. 1,53,000/- from District Vaishali and Rs. 94,900/- from District Aurangabad has been recovered during checking, which is under investigation by Police and Income Tax authority.

 - (x) Authenticated photo Voter Slip issued by the election machinery; and
 - (xi) Official identity cards issued to MPs/ MLAs/ MLCs.
